A fantastic summer sipper, the Flint & Steel Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc.

It's been too long since we've featured a Sauvignon Blanc here at Reverse Wine Snob. With so many different varieties of white wine out there we sometimes find ourselves overlooking the tried and true. Today's pick was a great reminder why you should always have a bottle of Sauvignon Blanc chilled and ready to drink.

The 2016 Flint & Steel Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc begins with a very pleasant aroma of grapefruit, lime and honeysuckle. True to its name it also features a bit of a flinty mineral note. Taking a sip launches

a tropical fruit fiesta in your mouth. Crisp and tasty grapefruit, kiwi and lime with touches of honey all combine with good acidity and a comforting mouthfeel to make this wine **a pleasure to drink**. Add in great balance and you've got an **extremely tasty** Sauvignon Blanc. It ends with an easy, satisfying finish of good length and some lingering tart tropical fruit.

This is one of those wines that's **hard not to take another sip** of especially if you're hanging out on the patio with friends. It grabs a well deserved spot on our list of **The Best Sauvignon Blanc under \$20!**
